

FEES

One Hour + Classes

\$11.00 per class – casual rate

Pre-Paid Ticket Prices

\$50.00 Book = 5 Classes (save \$5)

\$100.00 Book = 10 Classes (save \$10)

\$200.00 Book = 22 Classes (save \$42)

With our discount ticket system, no longer are you charged for classes you don't attend, nor do you have to pay for the term in advance. Simply present your ticket at the start of each class.

45min Classes (Junior Jazz)

\$7.00 per class – casual rate – no tickets

30min Classes (Tiny Tots)

\$5.00 per class – term paid in advance

i.e \$5 x 10 weeks = \$50

Tiny Tots and Baby Ballerinas must pay for the whole term in advance. These classes are in high demand so this ensures your child a place in the class even if you are away due to illness, holidays etc. However there are no refunds or credits given for any missed classes.

Enrolment Fee

Each dancer is required to pay the \$30 annual enrolment fee. This covers insurance, licences and private performance cover. (see below) This must be paid at the time of enrolment. 10% discount per family member, i.e 2 family members 10% discount, 3 family members 20% discount. This is an annual fee. Tiny tots classes are exempt.

Private Performance Cover

In addition to Vision extensive insurance cover, we offer each dancer personal accident cover. This covers the individual for ambulance, physiotherapy, hospital stays, dental and more for injury arising from training or performance etc. Policy information is available upon request.

Costume Fees

All costumes are hired from Vision. This means parents do not have to make or purchase any costumes. All costumes no matter how extravagant are \$20.00 each per performance.

Extra Costs

Correct dance and footwear must be worn to every class. Please refer to uniform list to find out what may be required for your class.

POLICIES — A FULL LIST CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE STUDIO

All students must enrol at the studio prior to commencement of any class. An enrolment form must be fully completed and signed by a parent or guardian and returned to Vision before classes commence. Your enrolment fee must be paid at this time. Personal details remain confidential. You will receive a Vision Newsletter at the start and end of every term, with more frequent notices given out during performance times. Please ensure that you check your child's dance bag regularly for any newsletter not passed on to you. Parents and guests are welcome to watch any class at Vision. This is a privilege so please respect the dancers and teachers by turning off mobile phones and remaining quiet throughout the class. Classes begin and end on time, Teachers are not to be interrupted during class. If you wish to discuss an issue please do so at the end of class or contact Vision after hours.

UNIFORMS

Dancers are required to wear correct footwear and clothing for every class. Students are encouraged to dress in the studio colours – red, black & white. This helps to promote studio unity and tidiness. Following is a guide on what to wear for each class.

Funk /Hip Hop/Jazz

Black jazz shoes or jazz sneakers. Comfortable clothing, no street clothing or school uniforms.

Cheerleading - Tumbling

White cheer sneakers (must be approved by teacher). Shorts only. No loose fitting garments. Fingernails must be kept short for safety!!

Ballet / Modern

Pink ballet shoes, pink ballet tights, black leotard and black wrap in winter. Hair off the face and in a bun.

Tap

Tan Tap shoes. We recommend low heels for beginners and adult must have black tap shoes. Comfortable dancewear.

Ballroom

Approved Ballroom shoes, comfortable dancewear.

Tiny Tots

Black Jazz shoes, comfortable dancewear including leotards, tights, shorts & t-shirts. No fairy dresses or costumes please.

Baby Ballerinas

Pink ballet leotard, pink ballet skirt, pink ballet tights and pink ballet shoes (not jiffies). Please do not wear fairy dresses or costumes to class.

Performance Troupe

Black jazz shoes, tan chorus shoes, pink ballet shoes, Vision Jacket and Vision T-shirt. Vipers must purchase their cheer uniform.

Hair must be tied up and off the face for all classes. No jewellery to be worn or brought to class.

All dancewear, shoes and personal items must be carefully labelled with your name. Vision is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. Vision and a large range for second-hand items are available. Vision also has a large range of our own customised dancewear that can be purchased at the studio.

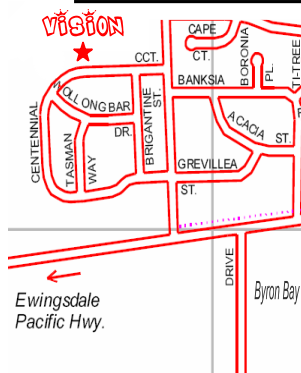

Students are placed into class according to age and ability. All students are invited to perform at our annual end of year concert held in December, and at the local eisteddfod in September.

Dance Team members and Vision Vipers squad selection is via teacher's assessment and student's commitment to dance as number one after school priority. Dance Team & Vipers members must attend at least two extra classes.

All classes are taught by qualified, experienced instructors. We offer the highest standard of dance education with creative and original choreography, costumes and performances.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

JAZZ / FUNK / HIP HOP – (JFH)

This is a high-energy class combining street style dance with fundamental jazz techniques. Turns, leap, jumps and break dance elements are just a small part of this class, which also incorporates flexibility and strength training. The style is often seen on current music videos and film clips.

CHEERLEADING

This class combines dance, acrobatics, strength training and gymnastic stunts. Vision is one of only a few studios in Australia that is teaching 'American' style cheerleading made popular by the film 'Bring it on'. We have designed a program to suit all ages and level for both boys and girls.

CLASSICAL BALLET

Dancers learn a Russian Vaganova Styled syllabus. Barre, centre work and progressions help to develop a strong dance technique. Exams are optional for the dedicated dancer.

TAP

The most rhythmic of the dance forms. Tap is an excellent way to increase coordination of the body and mind and to develop a sense of rhythm, timing and expression.

CONTEMPORARY

Using Graham & Cunningham techniques students learn fundamental body motion and awareness. Slow modern & lyrical elements are also incorporated. There is a strong focus on flexibility and progressions to develop correct technique.

MUSICAL THEATRE - Dance team members only

Students learn vocal technique and songs from popular musicals, Broadway and West End shows, as well as tunes from today's modern artists. Combined with stage styles cabaret dance, this is a fun a challenging class.

TINY TOTS – BABY BALLERINAS

An introduction to dance. This class is designed for students 2-5 years. Dancers learn basic steps, general motor skills and group interaction. Ballet students follow a BBO syllabus.

JUNIOR FUNKY JAZZ

This class is designed for young dancers 5 – 8 years who are discovering different styles of dance. Each 45min class covers technique, stretching, routines and fun games.

DANCE TEAM & VISION VIPERS

This is an additional class devoted to the teaching of team-based performance routines for eisteddfods and community displays. Dance Teams are primarily for selected students who wish to further their dance performance experience. This team encourages confidence, team spirit, commitment and leadership qualities. National and International performance opportunities are available to dance team members. 100 % commitment is required and must be the number one after school activity.
